



# Yandina State School 2017 Extra-curricular Activities

Our school is happy to offer the below Extra-curricular Activities at affordable prices to our students this year. Extra-curricular Activities are optional sporting activities or artistic adventures which fall outside of the normal curriculum. Some of these activities are funded by the school and others are requiring payment by you.

**Sporting Schools Grant** – Each Term the students will participate in a different sport which is funded by the Sporting Schools Grant.

**Where:** Noosa, near Main Beach, Noosa Woods, Beach Access 14. This is at the end of Hastings Street (you need to turn left at the Noosa Surf Club roundabout).

**When:** Every Thursday morning from 6:00am-7.15am. **Starting 16<sup>th</sup> February, Week 4 until the 16<sup>th</sup> March, Week 8**

**Who:** Any students in grade 3 or above, Mr Jennings and Mr Hatfield will attend the activity.

**Costs:** \$75.00 for 5 lessons (board hire included)
