This funding will be used to

- Increase the number of Year 3 & 5 students in the NAPLAN Upper 2 Bands in Reading and Number.
- Improve the number of students achieving at 'C' level and higher in A to E data Years 1 - 6.
- Improve the Mean Scale Score of Year 3 and Year 5 in Reading and Numeracy.
- Build staff and community capacity - 'High Performance Teams', staff wellbeing and parenting programs.
- Increase student attendance data to 92.7%.

Our initiatives include


- Professional development for whole school as the basis for coaching, in-class modelling, observation and feedback in Reading and Numeracy - Number.
- Train and implement North Coast Region 'High Performance Teams' program developing a High Performance School Action Plan and Implementing a Workforce Wellbeing 'E-Pulse' Survey Tool.
- Focus on attendance including student, class and school goals including parent education and communication regarding 'Every Day Counts'.
- Numeracy project focussing on number 'Warm Ups' and 'Open Ended Questions'.
- Implement a whole school Diverse Learners Support Model targeting intervention and enrichment programs.

Our school will improve student outcomes by

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| • Employ 0.4 Full Time Equivalent (FTE) Reading and Numeracy Coach. | \$34,000 |
| • Employ 0.6 FTE Student Services Officer - Attendance, Student Welfare and Behaviour (School Wide Positive Behaviour Support). | \$51,000 |
| • Purchase teacher relief (TRS) days providing support for teachers with collegial coaching, mentoring, feedback and observations. | \$10,000 |
| • Provide education programs for parents - PPP/ behaviour support / Numeracy. | \$350 |
| • Train and implement High Performance Teams and Workforce Well Being E Survey Tool. | \$10,000 |
