- Increase the percentage of students achieving at 'C' level or higher in Mathematics (Target 90%)
- Develop a deeper understanding of the Australian Curriculum, utilising high quality moderation processes to improve teaching and learning and ensure consistency of teacher judgements.

Our initiatives include

- Implement revised Yandina State School Reading program to ensure consistency of teacher practice
- Continue the implementation of the Yandina State School Moderation Cycle
- Review and refine the provision of resources to support learners
- Provide opportunities for professional learning and engage Regional support and expertise (Reading focus)
- Providing targeted support for early years based on Early Start - Literacy and Literacy Continuum materials
- Continue positive and proactive activities to encourage student attendance
- Continued focus on whole school community engagement and wellbeing

Our school will improve student outcomes by

• Increasing teacher aide support across the school	\$20,000
• Early intervention for Prep students	\$5,000
• Provide support to teachers to implement the Australian Curriculum, moderate student assessment and plan for differentiated teaching	\$26,000
• Ensure adequate resources are available to implement effective teaching and learning	\$85,299
• Targeted support in English (Reading focus) across all year level	\$18,000
